

I. Beautiful Head

1. Christ is the Head of the church ([Eph. 1:20-23](#)).
 - a. We are not talking about outward beauty ([Isa. 53:2-3](#)).
 - b. Remember, God looks upon the heart ([1 Sam. 16:7](#)).
2. Christ's beauty is seen in what He did and does for His church.
 - a. He gave His life for her ([Eph. 5:25](#)).
 - b. He redeemed her from death ([1 Pt. 1:18-19](#)).
 - c. He purchased her with His blood ([Ac. 20:28](#)).
 - d. He is her Savior ([Eph. 5:23](#)).
 - e. He sustains her day by day ([Eph. 5:28-30](#); [Col. 3:4](#)).
3. Christ's beauty is seen in His obedience to the Father.
 - a. His goal was to always do the Father's will ([Jn. 5:30](#), [8:29](#)).

II. Beautiful Body

1. The body of Christ is the church ([Eph. 1:22-23](#)).
2. The beauty of the church is seen in her holiness.
 - a. Holiness is beautiful ([Ps. 29:2](#), [96:9](#); [1 Ch. 16:29](#)).
 - b. The church must be sanctified, clean, without spot, without wrinkle, holy, and without blemish ([Eph. 5:26-27](#)).
3. The beauty of the church is seen in her selection by God.
 - a. She is the chosen people ([1 Pt. 2:9](#)).
 - b. There is beauty in who God selects ([Num. 17:1-10](#)).
4. The beauty of the church is seen in her obedience.
 - a. The church is subject to her Head ([Eph. 5:24](#)).
 - b. A people zealous of good works ([Tt. 2:14](#)).
5. The beauty of the church must be genuine ([Mt. 23:27-28](#)).
 - a. There is no beauty in putting on a show to be seen of men ([Mt. 6:1-8](#), [16-18](#)).

III. Beautiful Feet

1. There are many ugly things that people are involved in ([2 Tim. 3:1-5](#); cf. [Rm. 1:18-32](#); [Gal. 5:19-21](#)).
 - a. This results in many ugly feet.
 - b. Feet that be swift in running to mischief ([Pr. 6:18](#)).
 - c. Feet that are swift to shed blood ([Rm. 3:15](#)).
 - d. Feet that run to evil ([Pr. 1:16](#)).
2. Christianity has beautiful feet which spread the gospel ([Rm. 10:15](#); [Isa. 52:7](#)).
 - a. They are beautiful feet because they are carrying forth a beautiful message!
 - b. This is how Christianity counteracts all the ugliness in the world.
 - c. We also counteract this by walking as God would have us to walk ([Eph. 2:10](#), [4:1](#), [5:2](#), [8](#), [15](#)).
